Summary of Award Terms and Policies**

As you consider the award opportunity through the Google Cybersecurity Clinics Fund please be aware of the following anticipated grant terms as well as our privacy policies. **Expected Grant Terms**

Should you be offered an award, you will receive grant terms with your award letter. Following are the expected conditions of the grant ("Grant Funds"), subject to change:

- No more than 10% of this grant can be used for general, indirect costs.
- Your organization agrees to submit to Tides reports following the agreed upon report schedule.
  - Grant recipients will be expected to report on the impact of the grant once annually by January 31 over the course of the six year grant period.
- Any portion of the Grant Funds not used for the stated purpose must be repaid to Tides by your organization. Any change of purpose must be requested and approved by Tides in advance, in writing.
- All expenditures made with the Grant Funds shall appear in your organization's financial records, and such records will be made available to Tides Foundation at reasonable times upon request.
- Your organization agrees to notify Tides immediately, in writing, of any change in its tax-exempt status, its executive staff or key staff responsible for achieving the purpose of the Grant Funds, or any other change in its program that would affect its ability to achieve the purpose of the Grant Funds.
- Your organization certifies its receipt of the Grant Funds will not negatively impact Google's current or future ability to do business with your organization.
- Your organization will not use any portion of the Grant Funds to (i) purchase any products or services manufactured by Google (including its subsidiaries or affiliates), (ii) purchase any items from the Google Store (<https://store.google.com>), or (iii) make any grant or loan, pay compensation, reimburse expenses, or make any other similar payment to Google, any investment or other advisor of Google, or any related parties of Google or such investment or other advisor. Your organization acknowledges and understands that it is not expected to make any business or other decisions favorable to Google as a result of receiving the Grant Funds.
- Your organization must not use any of the grant funds to promote or engage in violence, terrorism or the destruction of property or to provide support or make payments to any person or entity that promotes or engages in such activities.
- Your organization will not use any portion of this grant to make sub-grants or sub-contracts to individuals on a non-objective basis, or for any non-charitable or non-educational purpose. The Grant Funds do not represent the payment of a pledge or other financial obligation. No goods or services should be provided in return for the Grant Funds.
- Your organization will not use any portion of the Grant Funds to engage in any political or lobbying activity, including carrying on propaganda or attempting to influence specific legislation either by direct or grassroots lobbying. For the sake of clarity, this clause does not prohibit your organization from engaging in legally permissible political or lobbying activities, provided your organization does not use the Grant Funds for such activities.
- Your organization has not violated and will not violate any federal or state laws applicable to

campaign finance, prohibited political activity, or lobbying limitations or reporting rules, and will indemnify, defend and hold Tides Foundation harmless from all costs or damages incurred by Tides arising out of your organization's activities, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

- Your organization agrees that if Grant Funds are used to create intellectual property, your organization will place (a) any such code or such other inventions under the Apache 2.0 license (<https://opensource.org/licenses/Apache-2.0>), and (b) any other such intellectual property (e.g. creative works that are not code, or patentable) under the CC-BY 4.0 International license (<https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/>) within three (3) months from the date of creation. Such intellectual property will be made freely available and searchable by major internet search engines. For any intellectual property rights (including patent and trade secret rights) not licensed by your organization under one of the above licenses, your organization will place such intellectual property in the public domain. Your organization will not file any patent applications in connection with any intellectual property created with the Grant Funds. With respect to any data created with Grant Funds, such data will be made freely available and searchable by major internet search engines subject to any applicable data privacy laws. To the extent applicable, the work your organization undertakes with grant funds will comply with Google's Artificial Intelligence Principles set forth at <https://ai.google/principles/>.
- Your organization agrees that the Grant Funds will be designated for service programs open to all persons regardless of religion, and will not be used for religious instruction.
- Your organization certifies that it does not discriminate against any person or group of people in either hiring or employment practices or in the administration of programs and services, including on the basis of sexual orientation or gender identity.
- Your organization agrees to comply with all applicable export laws and trade sanctions programs. Your organization agrees to comply with all applicable laws, including all anti-bribery or anti-corruption laws. Your organization and officers, directors, employees, or agents have not and will not pay, offer or promise to pay, or authorize the payment directly or indirectly, of any money, gift or anything of value to any government official or employee or any political party or candidate for political office for the purpose of influencing any act or decision of such official or of the government to obtain or retain business, or direct business to your organization. Your organization certifies that the use of Grant Funds will comply with all applicable government ethics laws, including gift limits. Your organization certifies that it will not use the Grant Funds to honor any government officials.
- Your organization certifies that it is legally authorized to receive this grant under its own policies, as well as any other applicable laws and regulations. Your organization certifies that the person accepting payment has the authority and has obtained all necessary approvals to accept the Grant Funds, including to make the certifications and to comply with the covenants and restrictions included in this letter.
- If the Donor or Fund Advisor is known to you, your organization agrees that it shall not use any portion of this grant to make any grant or loan, pay compensation, reimburse expenses, or make any other similar payment to: (i) any Donor to this Fund, (ii) any Fund Advisor to this Fund, (iii) any Relative of a Donor or Fund Advisor to this Fund, or (iv) any Controlled Entity.

### ***Tides Applicant Data Disclosure***

*Your name, title, work email, and work phone number will be retained by Tides for the duration of the open call application process and will be deleted within three months of the open call window closing. Your name, title, work email, and work phone number will be redacted while your application is reviewed by the application review panel. The information you provide through this application will be used by Tides in accordance with [Tides' Privacy Policy](#).*

*If your application is selected as a finalist, your name and work email will be shared with Google LLC and the Consortium of Cybersecurity in connection with your application and for purposes of communicating with you about further opportunities. By submitting this application, you agree to Tides transmitting your name and work email to Google LLC and the Consortium of Cybersecurity Clinics in the event your application is selected as a finalist and their handling of such data in accordance with their respective privacy policies.*

### ***Tides Applicant Data Deletion Policy***

*Tides will delete your name, title, work email, and work phone number within three months of the application window closing if your application is not selected.*

*If your application is selected and Google recommends a grant to your organization through the Google.org Charitable Giving Fund at Tides Foundation, Tides will retain your name, title, work email, and work phone number for the purposes of communicating with you regarding your potential grant and, if awarded, any reporting expectations of your organization.
